

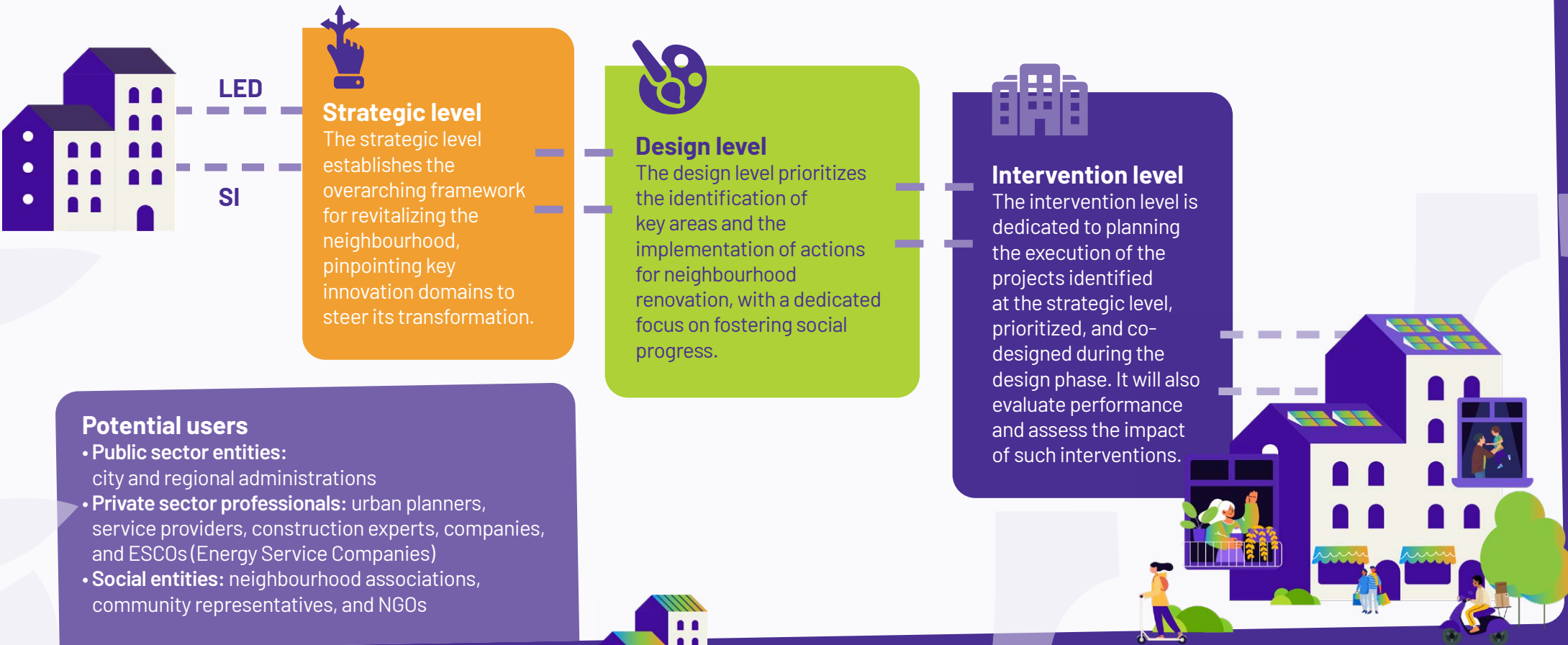

1 The Integrated Methodology Renovation for Social Housing Neighbourhoods (IRM)
aims to transform social housing districts into inclusive smart communities, supporting cities in neighbourhood regeneration.

2 The core objective of IRM
is to reshape social housing districts, fostering inclusivity, integrating smart technology, **promoting social innovation (SI), and stimulating local economic development (LED).**

planning, implementation, monitoring, and replication efforts, drawing insights from ongoing processes in the **Santa Ana neighbourhood in Ermua (Spain), Elva (Estonia), and Matera (Italy).**
